Oyster Creek Generating Station Receives Corporate
Funding for Biodiversity Projects
\$6,100 will help to fund programs related to birds, butterflies and turtles

FORKED RIVER, N.J. (April 20, 2007) – As part of its Earth Day celebrations, Exelon Corporation presented a check to the Oyster Creek Generating Station in the amount of \$6,100 to fund various biodiversity projects. The Biodiversity Council at the station was formed to help improve positive public exposure to Oyster Creek’s environmental programs.

The Council was awarded this money to help fund four programs. Those programs are:

- **Peregrine Falcon and Osprey Nest Platform** - Erect a nest box platform under the guidance of the New Jersey Endangered and Non-Game Species Program and Toms River Avian Care to encourage nesting of Peregrine Falcons and Ospreys.
- **Nest Box Program** - Build and install nest boxes on company property to encourage nesting of American Kestrels, Barred Owls and other cavity nesting birds. The boxes will be monitored for activity and documented.
- **Habitat Enhancement for Pollinators and Birds** - Create a wildlife on company property with educational materials about pollinator-friendly plants to improve employee awareness of property enhancements and encourage employees to replicate on their own properties.
- **Diamondback Terrapin Conservation** - Promote diamondback terrapin conservation (a turtle species) in decline across their range, through active student and community participation in Ocean County, N.J. Join students, educators and scientists together in an effort to protect terrapins, which will also fill a void by developing curriculum, to be used both locally and nationally. This project is part of the Ocean County Vocational and Technical School’s Marine Academy of Technology and Environmental Science’s (MATES) program
